**NOTICE OF FILING AND PUBLIC HEARING**

Pursuant to the provisions of the R.I.G.L. §39-3-15, §39-3-17 and §39-38-18, as amended, the Division of Public Utilities and Carriers (“Division”) will conduct a public hearing on **Wednesday, December 7, 2022 at 1:30 P.M.** in Hearing Room B at the Division’s office located at 89 Jefferson Boulevard, Warwick, Rhode Island.

At this hearing, the Division will consider the propriety of an application by the Pawtucket Water Supply Board for approval to borrow an amount not to exceed fifteen million dollars (\$15,000,000) through revenue bonds to be sold by the Rhode Island Infrastructure Bank for the Rhode Island Safe Drinking Water State Revolving Fund. These proceeds will be used to fund meter replacement project, lead services inventory and improvements to the Pawtucket Water Supply Board's distribution system. The borrowing will be secured by a pledge of the Pawtucket Water Supply Board's revenues.
