PETITION TO AMEND MULTI-YEAR RATE PLAN

(Issued May 10, 2022)

BCWA 1-1: In Providence's Petition to Amend Multi-Year Rate Plan, it asks the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission to postpone the implementation of its step three increase in Docket 4994 from Fiscal Year 2023 (effective July 1, 2022) to Fiscal Year 2024 (effective July 1, 2023). If the Commission grants Providence's petition, does Providence agree that it will have to file a compliance filing and obtain the Commission's approval before implementing a rate increase in Fiscal Year 2024?

RESPONSE: Yes.
