On behalf of Rhode Island Energy,¹ enclosed please find the Company's Lighting Inventory Report providing the distribution of lighting inventory by wattage range with actual output information in compliance with the Rhode Island Public Utilities Commission's Report and Order No. 21704, at page 48, Paragraph 6, in the above-referenced docket.

As of the annual inventory date of April 1, 2024, 26 customers received service on the Street and Area Lighting – Customer Owned Equipment S-05 Tariff, RIPUC No. 2231. One of those customers notified Rhode Island Energy of light emitting diode (“LED”) street and area lighting installations prior to the date of this report. The attached report sets forth the distribution of street and area lighting inventory by billable wattage range with actual system wattage for the LED street lights.
